# From Principal

#### SCHOOL CLOSURE DAY

Today the staff have engaged in a faith formation and Religious Education curriculum day. Professor Clare Johnson, who is a Professor of Liturgical Studies and Sacramental Theology and Director of the ACU Centre for Liturgy, facilitated our morning session. Clare has liturgical studies, sacramental theology, preaching, liturgical music, and introductory theology at the University of Notre Dame (USA), Michigan State University (USA), the University of Notre Dame Australia (Fremantle) and the Australian Catholic University (Melbourne).

Clare led the staff through some (already prepared) lessons centred on the Sunday's Gospel Readings, Saint Days and special days throughout the liturgical year. Clare's focus was to provide the teachers with friendly activities that model how to use scripture in the classroom.
