

## *From Principal*

### **SCHOOL CLOSURE DAY**

Next Friday, 6 June, there will be no school for the children. This is a school closure day. The staff will be engaging in professional learning with a specific focus on Religious Education and liturgy.

There will also be no school on Monday, 9 June, as this is a public holiday for the King's Birthday.

### **SCHOOL CONCERT**

Next week we will be celebrating our school concert. The preparation by Ineke Waller has been meticulous, and I know it is going to be an amazing success. The children seem very excited about performing. It is going to be a wonderful opportunity for them to showcase the 'Performing Arts' program.

There will be at least 1 hour between drop off and pick up. The Besen Centre has a bar and refreshments that will be open from 6.00pm - 7.00pm. Consistent with our Child Safety Code of Conduct policy I have liaised with the School Advisory Council on this. We have decided that opening the bar for an hour for 1-2 refreshing drinks is reasonable and does not pose a risk to any students. If we were not to use the bar we would be charged \$350 as per the Besen Centres conditions. It will be nice for families to mingle and engage with each other whilst waiting for the venue to be open for seating.

- Minor Capital Works - 2-3 Year Plan


### **GAGA PIT**

I am currently receiving quotes to build the children a new play space. The image below is called a Gaga Pit. It is a ball game called Gaga Ball. Gaga ball, is a fast-paced, high-energy sport played in a specially designed pit. Players use their hands to hit a soft ball at each other, with the goal of being the last person standing by hitting opponents below the knee. The game combines dodging, jumping, running, and striking. We have played this game on school camps, and the children love it.



## NOTABLES PRESENTATIONS

On Wednesday our Year 5/6 children presented their Notables projects to the rest of the school and many parents and relatives who visited. The children demonstrated great knowledge of their notable person who they believe has made a significant difference to others. They should be proud of their research and the confident manner in which they shared their learning.



## DECODABLE READERS - SYNTHETIC PHONICS

I am investigating purchasing hard copies of readers for our Prep - Year 2 Synthetic Phonics program. At the moment the children are needing to use devices for their home reading. This can present challenges. We are seeing some very strong data from this approach to teaching literacy and need to continue to resource the program so that our children are given the best opportunity to develop their reading proficiency.

Both the Strawberry Fair funds and some funds for the Parents' Association will enable us to be able to install the Gaga Pit and much-needed readers for our P-2 children. The School Advisory Council will be consulted on this next Tuesday, and before any purchases or construction occur. Expenditure items like this also need to be approved by the school's Business Manager.

## PREP ENROLMENTS 2025 - REPEAT

We currently have 28 Preps enrolled to start Prep at St Anne's in 2026. We still have families who have attended school tours and have not yet submitted an application, so this number should increase further. Some of our families are awaiting Government school offers, which come out in August.

We have 34 Year 6 children graduating at the end of the year. We always aim to have the same number of children enrolled as we do graduating each year.

*Families are our best marketing tool, so I ask that if you know families who have a child starting school next year that you encourage them to call the office and make a time to come along for a tour of our wonderful school.*

Bronwyn Grenfell has done a great job advertising school tours. Anthony Molinaro and O'Brien's Real Estate have been very generous again in promoting school tours, installing many advertising boards around the local area.

## School Production (5th June) - Purchasing Tickets via Try Booking






